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ACCELERATED READER QUIZ SUPPORT

Lordsburg Press provides two teacher-made quiz templates for *The Beacon Keepers: First Light* that educators may manually enter through the Renaissance Accelerated Reader Teacher-Made Quiz system, if their school uses that feature.

Set A focuses on plot recall and key story events. This is the stronger option for an AR-style reading comprehension check.

Set B focuses on character moments, belonging, trust, integrity, and emotional turning points. This set is best used as a classroom reflection quiz, discussion check, or companion activity after reading.

Both sets follow the Teacher-Made Quiz format: 10 multiple-choice questions with four answer choices each. Teachers and librarians should follow their school or district’s AR procedures when creating or assigning teacher-made quizzes.
